START HERE:

EXTRA THINGS

There are different words for "love" in the original language of the New Testament.

One word refers to friendship.

Another refers to family affection.

And another refers to romantic and physical desire.

Paul uses a different word here. It's **agape** (uh-GAH'-pay). This is the kind of love that God has for his people and that God wants his people to have for both him and each other.

Agape is divine.

God naturally has agape love for us. But we can only express and experience agape love for God and others with the Spirit's help.
